

## **Install & Update Guide**

Daytona Twin Tec — Windows 7 through Windows 11

Must be connected to the internet for all steps.

## **New/Fresh Install Procedure**

1 Download and run the TCFI Software Installer.

2 Download and run the Launcher Update (Auto Extract EXE).

- 3 From your desktop, run TCFI Launcher.
- 4 Update the software:
  - Click the button: Check For Software Update.
  - When prompted, Save the file.
  - The file will auto run.
  - Click **OK** to elevate permissions (UAC).
  - Click Extract. Do not change the destination folder (correct for most Windows 7–11 installs).
  - If asked to replace files, choose Yes to All.
  - Back in TCFI Launcher, click the software to run: PC\_Link or TCFI\_Log.

Tip: If you have trouble connecting to devices, update to the latest FTDI USB Drivers. From the launcher, click "Read USB Driver PC Version Compare To Latest Version". It reads your PC's driver and the latest available online; if an update is required, you'll be sent to the correct link with instructions.

## **Existing Install Procedure**

Ensure all Daytona Twin Tec software is closed before starting.

- 1 Close all DTT tuning software on your PC.
- 2 Download and run the Launcher Update (Auto Extract EXE).

- 3 From your desktop, run TCFI Launcher.
- 4 Update the software:
  - Click Check For Software Update.
  - When prompted, **Save** the file.
  - The file will auto run.
  - Click **OK** to elevate permissions (UAC).
  - Click Extract. Do not change the destination folder (correct for most Windows 7–11 installs).
  - If asked to replace files, choose Yes to All.
  - Back in TCFI Launcher, click the software to run: PC\_Link or TCFI\_Log.
